PHASE 1

Renovation of the F. Marie Hall Outpatient Campus

Completed November 11, 2024, this phase included:

- Replacement roof and exterior walls
- Interior updates to accommodate relocated hospital departments

PHASE 2

Expanding Capacity and Access

Currently 75% complete and on track for March 2026, this phase adds:

- Two new operating rooms
- A retail pharmacy
- A new endoscopy waiting area
- A Professional Office Building for Human Resources, Medical Records, and Midland Memorial Foundation
- Relocation and expansion of the Cardiopulmonary Department

PHASE 3

Innovation and Patient Care

Phase 3 will bring new life to the Abell-Hanger Pavilion, expected to be completed by December 2026. Plans include:

- A new outpatient infusion center on the first floor
- A Simulation Center on the second floor to enhance clinical training

As part of Phase II of the Facility Master Plan, the Cardiopulmonary Department is being expanded and relocated to enhance patient care. Peggy and the late Timber Floyd have made a generous donation in support of the department. This thoughtful gift was made in honor of Dr. Saranya Rajasekar, whose exceptional care and compassion left a lasting impression on the Floyds. Their contribution is supporting the physical transformation of the department, along with the purchase of essential new equipment, including chest compression vests and other advanced technologies designed to improve patient outcomes. With expanded space and innovative tools, the department will be equipped to deliver more effective care for patients.

I was born and raised in different parts of California and moved to Midland, Texas after I got married in 1992. I began working at Midland Memorial Hospital as a Nurse Tech (now called Nurse Intern). This hospital gave me more than just a job, it gave me my career. Everything I have achieved has been possible because of the generosity of Midland Memorial Foundation.


The Foundation funded every nursing degree I've earned, beginning with my associate's degree in 2008. I started my nursing journey as a first-semester student in the ED at the West Campus. This hospital taught me how to be a nurse, a leader, and a lifelong learner. In an environment of constant growth, I was encouraged to chase my dreams even when it felt like pressure. My mentor, Kit, knew that pushing me out of my comfort zone was exactly what I needed. As the youngest in my family and the first to attend college, I'm grateful for that encouragement.

With the Foundation's support, I went on to earn my BSN in 2015, my MSN in 2020, and I am now pursuing my DNP at Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center. "Go Raiders!" Today, as the Director of Emergency Services, I feel a deep responsibility to honor the legacy of those who led before me. My goal is to make this department a model of nursing excellence and recognition. Completing my DNP will give me the tools to lead more effectively, shape meaningful projects, and present ideas to hospital leadership that will benefit both staff and patients.

Over the years, I've also earned certifications as a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (2011), Cardiovascular Registered Nurse, Emergency Nurse, and Nurse Manager Leader. In 2021, I completed the AONL Nurse Director Fellowship a program I didn't know I needed, but one that has been invaluable. Each step of this journey has been made possible with the support of Midland Memorial Hospital and the Foundation.

Through the MMF Nursing Scholarship Fund, our donors have opened doors for Dana and many others, investing not only in education but in the future of healthcare in Midland.

Midland Memorial Foundation Community Outreach



Hope Chest

Hope Chest is an incentives-based program for pregnant women and new mothers of all ages and backgrounds, focusing on the health of babies across the Permian Basin. The program encourages positive behaviors during pregnancy and beyond.

Through a points system, mothers can earn essentials like diapers, wipes, clothing, car seats, and more. Both mother and baby are eligible until the child turns two years old. Points are earned by attending doctor's appointments, participating in childbirth education classes, and practicing healthy, responsible behaviors.

Without prenatal care, babies are three times more likely to be underweight and five times more likely to die in infancy, whereas consistent prenatal and postnatal care can reduce neonatal deaths by 41%. Hope Chest removes barriers, offers encouragement, and rewards mothers for attending vital checkups.

Leslie's Place, located inside of Casa de Amigos, is a community clinic providing free healthcare to uninsured adults. The clinic offers primary care, wellness checkups, preventive screenings, and prescription assistance every Tuesday and Thursday from 4:00 PM to 8:00 PM. No appointments are required, with patients seen on a first-come, first-served basis.

Thanks to the partnership between Casa de Amigos, Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center, and Midland Health, Leslie's Place has made a remarkable impact since opening in August 2023. The clinic has served 1,500 patients, offering wellness checkups, preventive screenings, and prescription assistance, helping uninsured adults gain access to essential healthcare services.




